**Schedule:** The League will bowl on Fridays for 30 weeks, beginning September 6, 2024 & finishing on April 18, 2025. Practice will start at 12:15 PM and competition at 12:30 PM. There will be no bowling on the following Fridays: 29 November 2024, 27 December 2024 & 3 January 2025.

- <u>1) Team Rosters</u>: The Team mix shall be a minimum of 1 member of the opposite sex. Seniors aged 50 and older are eligible to bowl in this Senior League.
- <u>2) Board of Directors</u>: Consist of league officers and team captains. The board of directors will handle all league business and disputes.
- 3) Bowling Fees: The weekly fee to be paid by each member, each week is \$17.00 broken down as follows; \$12.00 Bowling Fees, \$.50 Secretary Fee, \$.25 President's Fee, \$4.25 Prize Fund. This is a "Guaranteed" league which means league bowlers are responsible for paying \$17.00 per week including any "Absent" days. Absent fee: \$17.00 unless a substitute is available; subs pay \$12.00 & bowler pays \$5.00. Bowling fees (\$17.00) for the last week (week 30) shall be paid by the 2nd week of the season. Bowlers may not be more than 2 weeks in arrears. A bowler must give 2 weeks' notice if they must quit the league.

## 4) USBC Sanctioned: No

- <u>5) League Banking</u>: League Funds will be deposited weekly into the Senior Bowling League bank account at 1st Bank. The President & Audit Committee shall verify the account balance each month.
- **6) Committees**: The league president shall appoint an Audit Committee to audit the financial status of the league. The League President shall present a minimum of 2 prize fund options to be voted on by the league. The options must be distributed to each team by the 5th week of the season.
- **7) Averages**: Will be established on the 1st day of bowling. If a bowler bowls a minimum of 1 game but is unable to complete the 2nd and/or the 3rd game, the bowler's average and handicap for that day will be based on the number of games bowled. This average and computed handicap will be used for all games bowled on the first day and subsequent days until the bowler completes additional games.
- **8) Handicap**: Shall be 90% of the difference between the individual's average & 210.
- 9) Substitutes: Will be allowed: YES. Substitutes are not permitted to bowl during the last week.
- **10)** Legal Lineup: 2 Regular bowlers OR 1 regular bowler and 1 substitute must be present by the end of the third frame of any game to qualify as a legal lineup. Late bowlers may enter any game provided 3 Frames have not been completed for that game. The 3rd frame shall be considered completed when all bowlers present on each team have made his/her last deliveries in the 3rd

frame. A new Team can be added only through the 2nd week of scheduled bowling. Note: When an absentee score is required, the team must use the score for the absent bowler with the most games bowled. However, our league does not allow 4 men or 4 women to bowl as a team; violation of this rule will result in a team forfeit.

- <u>11) Absentee Score</u>: A bowler's current average and handicap will be used for 2 consecutive weeks. On the 3rd and subsequent weeks missed, the absent bowler will have 10 pins subtracted from his/her average and the handicap will remain the same.
- **12) Vacant Score**: Vacant score shall be 120 average per game, with an 81 handicap (total 201). In the event of a vacant team, the team bowling the vacant team must bowl their team average minus 40 pins to receive a win for that game.
- 13) Position Round: One Position Round will be scheduled for the last day of bowling.
- **14) Standing Points**: The following points will be awarded each week; 1 point for each team game won, and 1 point for team series.
- 16) Pre-Bowls & Make-ups: The Secretary or President must be notified in advance before a pre-bowl or make-up is booked (except for emergencies or adverse weather conditions). Pre-bowls & Make-ups should be scheduled in advance with the bowling center. Only team pre-bowls and make-ups are permitted. All make-ups must be completed within 2 weeks of the scheduled date, and prior to the last day of competition.
- 17) Forfeit: In the event of a forfeit or a "vacant" team, the team present must bowl their team average minus 40 pins to receive a win for that game. Points not won for failing to bowl the minimum score will not be credited to the team that forfeited.
- **18) Miscellaneous**: Team captains are responsible for turning in their team envelope to the secretary by the end of the 1st game. All spectators and children are not allowed in the bowler's area during league competition.
