Schedule:	League will bowl 15 weeks beginning Wednesday May 7th, 2025 and ending Wednesday August 13th, 2025. Practice will start at 5pm and league play will begin at 5:15pm.			
Sanction:	This is a USBC sanctioned league. All bowlers, including substitutes, must be sanctioned. Sanction fee for summer 2024/2025 season is \$10.00 or \$30.00.			
Team Roster:	3 bowlers per team any mix. The roster can hold up to 5 bowlers.			
Bowling Fees:	The weekly fee to be paid by each member, each week is \$20.00 and the fee breakdown is as follows:

	The last two weeks of bowling shall be paid by the 5 th week of bowling. Bowlers may not be more than 2 weeks in arrears. A bowler must give two weeks' notice if they must quit the league.			
Averages:	Averages will be established the first night of bowling no matter number of games. No bowlers will be able to establish an average on position round.			
Handicap:	Handicap shall be 90% of the difference between individual's average and 230. Handicap will be computed after the first night of bowling and applied to the games bowled that night.			

- Legal Lineup: A legal line up shall consist of 1 bowlers (1 regular) and must be present by the end of the 3rd frame of any game. A vacancy bowler does not count towards a legal line up. Late bowlers may enter a game provided 3 frames have not been completed.
- Substitutes: Substitutes will be allowed; however, only rostered bowlers are allowed to bowl position rounds.
- Absentee Score: A bowler's average will be used for a maximum of 3 consecutive weeks. On the 4th consecutive week missed the blind score will be reduced by 10 pins every consecutive week.
- Vacancy Score: The vacancy score will be 140 per game, with a 81 handicap. In the event of a vacant team, the team bowling against the vacancy team must bowl within 30 pins of their team average to receive the win for that game. A new team filling the vacant team spot will take over any wins the vacant team earned.
- Forfeit:In the event of a forfeit, the team present must bowl their average minus 30 pins, in
order to receive a win for that game. Points not won for failing to bowl the minimum
score will not be credited for the team that forfeited.

Position Rounds: No Position Rounds will be held.

Standing Points: The following points will be awarded each week, for a total of 4 points:

1 Points for each game won

1 Point for team series won

Pre-Bowls/Make-Up :Pre-bowls and make-ups are permitted and must be scheduled in advance with the bowling center. All make-ups must be completed within 2 weeks or before the next position round whichever comes first. All pre-bowls and make-ups must be completed prior to the position round. Only pre-bowls are permitted on position round.
